

TERMS OF WEBSITE USE

This document (together with the documents referred to on it) informs you of the terms of use on which you may use our websites: www.obn.org.uk, www.biotrinity.com, www.bioforward.co.uk, www.obn-awards.com, bioseed.eu (“our sites”), whether as a guest or a registered user. Please read these terms of use carefully before you start to use our sites. By using our sites, you indicate that you accept these terms of use and that you agree to abide by them. If you do not agree to these terms of use, please refrain from using our sites.

Information about us

Our sites are operated by OBN (UK) Ltd (“We”). We are registered in England and Wales under company number 06618658 and have our registered office at 5F Park Square, Milton Park, Oxfordshire, OX14 4RR, UK. Our main trading address is the same. Our VAT number is 935 2567 09.

Accessing our sites

Access to our sites is permitted on a temporary basis, and we reserve the right to withdraw or amend the service we provide on our sites without notice (see below). We will not be liable if for any reason our sites are unavailable at any time or for any period. From time to time, we may restrict access to some parts of our sites, or our entire sites, to users who have registered with us.

If you choose, or you are provided with, a user identification code, password or any other piece of information as part of our security procedures, you must treat such information as confidential, and you must not disclose it to any third party. We have the right to disable any user identification code or password, whether chosen by you or allocated by us, at any time, if in our opinion you have failed to comply with any of the provisions of these terms of use.

Prohibited uses

You may use our sites only for lawful purposes. You may not use our sites:

- in any way that breaches any applicable local, national or international law or regulation;
- in any way that is unlawful or fraudulent, or has any unlawful or fraudulent purpose or effect;
- to send, knowingly receive, upload, download, use or re-use any material which does not comply with our content standards (as set out below);
- to transmit, or procure the sending of, any unsolicited or unauthorised advertising or promotional material or any other form of similar solicitation (spam); or
- to knowingly transmit any data, send or upload any material that contains viruses, Trojan horses, worms, time-bombs, keystroke loggers, spyware, adware or any other harmful programs or similar computer code designed to adversely affect the operation of any computer software or hardware.

You also agree:

- not to reproduce, duplicate, copy or re-sell any part of our sites; and
- not to access without authority, interfere with, damage or disrupt any part of our sites, any equipment or network on which our sites are stored, any software used in the provision of our sites, or any equipment or network or software owned or used by any third party.

Interactive services

We may from time to time provide interactive services on our sites, including, without limitation: bulletin boards; news groups; forums; communities; and/or other message or communication facilities designed to enable you to communicate with the public at large or a group (the “**interactive services**”).

Where we do provide any interactive service, we will provide clear information to you about the kind of service offered, if it is moderated and what form of moderation is used (including whether it is human or technical). However, we are under no obligation to oversee, monitor or moderate any interactive service we provide on our sites, and we expressly exclude our liability for any loss or damage arising from the use of any interactive service by a user in contravention of our content standards, whether the service is moderated or not.

Where we do moderate an interactive service, we will normally provide you with a means of contacting the moderator, should a concern or difficulty arise.

Content standards

You must comply to these content standards, they apply to any and all material which you contribute to our sites (**contributions**), and to any interactive services associated with it. The standards apply to each part of any contribution as well as to its whole.

Contributions must:

- be accurate (where they state facts);

- be made in breach of any legal duty owed to a third party, such as a contractual duty or a duty of confidence;
- be threatening, abusive or invade another's privacy, or be likely to cause annoyance, harassment, embarrassment or alarm to any other person;
- give the impression that they emanate from us, if this is not the case.

Intellectual property rights

We are the owner or the licensee of all intellectual property rights in our sites, and in the material published on it. Those works are protected by copyright laws and treaties around the world. All such rights are reserved.

You may print off one copy, and may download extracts, of any page(s) from our sites for your personal reference and you may draw the attention of others within your organisation to material posted on our sites. You must not modify the paper or digital copies of any materials you have printed off or downloaded in any way, and you must not use any illustrations, photographs, video

Information about you and your visits to our sites

Transactions concluded through our sites

Contracts for the supply of goods, services or information formed through our sites or as a result of visits made by you are governed by our terms and conditions of supply unless otherwise stated by us.

Uploading material to our sites

Whenever you make use of a feature that allows you to upload material to our sites, or to make contact with other users of our sites, you must comply with the content standards set out above. You warrant that any such contribution does comply with those standards, and you indemnify us for any breach of that warranty.

We will not be responsible, or liable to any third party, for the content or accuracy of any materials posted by you or any other user of our sites.

We have the right to remove any material or posting you make on our sites if, in our opinion, such material does not comply with the content standards set out above.

Viruses, Hacking and other offences

We will not be liable for any loss or damage caused by a distributed denial-of-service attack, viruses or other technologically harmful material that may infect your computer equipment, computer programs, data or other proprietary material due to your use of our sites or to your downloading of any material posted on it, or on any websites linked to it.

These terms of use and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with them or their subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and Wales.
